- Submission Required submission documents are to be received **BEFORE** 26 October 2019.
- Confirmation Acceptance will be confirmed by email or fax **BEFORE** 2 November 2019.
- Publication Conference proceedings & white papers will be published on the conference portal for dissemination. Speakers implicitly grant the organizer the right to do so. Copyrights remain with the speaker(s)/author(s).
- Final Submission Confirmed speakers & authors are to submit their papers in PowerPoint & PDF **BEFORE** 31 Dec. 2019.
- Presenting Aides Computer (PC) using MS-Windows & hooked up to the venue's audio system; Beamer; Laser Pointer
NOTE: For logistical reasons, speakers will not be able to use their own computer to present.
- Submission Media Email, FPT upload, memory sticks, CD/DVD, "zipped" folder sent by large file transmission service.
